## **Important Reminders**

**Safety is always the first priority!**

**All Amateur dogs that qualify for Amateur Finals must have the proper registration and / or litter registration paperwork for that dog available upon request of the field trial committee.**

**Dan Ruffcorn is looking for volunteers to help with Youth Division Trial.**

**Non-Toxic Shot must be used at all times at the Wayne Fitzgerald State Recreation Area, this includes practices as well as competition. Game wardens will be present and checking and no exceptions will be made.**

**Any competitor using prohibited shot will be disqualified from the Nationals as well as his / her dogs.**

**Any Handler / Designated Shooter running a dog in qualifying must also run that dog in the finals.**

**A Handler / Designated Shooter is limited to a total of four (4) dogs per division which includes dogs that qualify for finals as High Points Dogs.**

**Disrespect shown to a judge, field marshal or fellow competitor and mistreatment of a dog will not be tolerated and may be grounds for immediate disqualification from the Nationals and other disciplinary actions.**

**We need volunteers to clear competition fields each morning, those of you running later in the day or those having dogs not competing in Division running that day, we need your help to to accomplish this each morning prior to competition.**

**We as members are direct reflection on our organization. We can expect visitors at the event, so please conduct yourselves at all times in a professional and courteous manner**
