All Amateur dogs that qualify for the National Amateur Finals must have the proper registration and/or litter registration paperwork on your dog submitted to the UFTA prior to or with Nationals Payment. If proper registration is not on file the amateur dog will not be allowed to run at Nationals.

Anyone, age 62 and over, who is interested in running in the Seniors Trial on Monday, February 26th please include the fee of \$125.00 per dog with your deposit. This will be a two (2) run event. Therefore, please indicate the dog(s) you plan to enter and include this fee with your deposit. You must run a dog that is qualified for the UFTA Nationals. This event is for the handler and not the dog. This event will have a payback.

The Youth Pointing & Flushing Division will be Saturday 2/22 through Tuesday 2/25. The Youth trials will be broken down into age groups, if we have enough participants. There will be a 2 - 7-year-old group, 8 - 17-year old non-shooter group and 14 - 17-year-old shooter group. Each group will earn prizes. A maximum of two dogs per youth per division. The 14 - 17-year-old shooter youth division may also enter the 8 - 17-year-old non-shooter Division. The Youth Trial will consist of one run. **Please call or Text Tracey Gazaway @ (706-455-7252). List your youth entry with age, division and # of dogs you intend to run in on the attached page.** Provisions can be made to run on different days throughout the week if time allows. A parent will be allowed to shoot for their child. UFTA will be covering a portion of the entry fee to facilitate the Youth event. **Entry fee will be \$30.00.**

This year's banquet will charge \$10.00/person in an effort to offset cost escalations.

REMINDERS:

1. If you are the Handler/Designated Shooter and run a dog in qualifying, you **MUST** run the dog in the Finals.
2. A dog that goes to the finals as one of the High Point Dogs, counts as one of the four (4) dogs that a Handler/Designated Shooter could possibly be taking to the finals.
3. The 2024 Nationals will require competitors to double blind, as always, but the competitors will be required to remain in the blind until their brace begins. Competitors in the blind will not be allowed to watch the brace before them. This requirement will be used for all divisions.
4. If you are registering and paying for someone else's dog(s), you must submit a separate registration form for each additional owner. You can secure a blank registration form from the website to complete this process. **Please register only the dogs listed on your form.**

A majority of Board members approved the following: **“At the Nationals, a handler/designated shooter can run no more than 6 dogs per day. A maximum of 4 dogs can be run per division. This format will be used at the 2024 nationals only. Field trailers that handle/shoot for 6 dogs will meet with the board to discuss run orders and will be monitored by the board. Pointing runs take precedence over flushing”**

The entry fee for each division is listed on your registration form which is enclosed with this letter. This year you have the option to either pay your fees in full or just the required deposit amount. Please choose to either pay the full amount or just the required deposit amount.

Your registration must be postmarked on or before Saturday, February 1, 2025 in order to participate.
